

RESOLUTION FOR OUTSIDE AGENCY ALLOCATIONS FOR
THE BUDGET YEARS 2010-2011

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

AUGUST 5, 2009

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners voted on July 8, 2009 to remove the automatic funding of general fund dollars to certain agencies; and

WHEREAS, this list of agencies includes: Blueprint for Aging, Dispute Resolution Center, Family Learning Institute, Legal Resource Center, Michigan Tenant Counseling, NAAPID, Neutral Zone, Project Grow, Retired Senior Volunteer Program, Southeastern Michigan Legal Services, Success by Six and UATS Reserve; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of general fund dollars that currently go to these agencies is \$283,750; and

WHEREAS, agencies funded through the Children's Well Being and Human Services Grants are subject to the competitive bidding and review process.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners amend the 2010/11 budget by adding the \$283,750 saved by removing certain agencies from automatic funding to the \$800,000 suggested for the Children's Well Being and Human Services Grants, for a total of \$1,083,750; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Community Development will allocate \$40,000 in Innovations grants to start-up programs or those programs not currently funded by Community Development that demonstrate innovative service and resource delivery to consumers in Washtenaw County; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners allocate funds to outside agencies as shown on the accompanying sheet; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it shall be the policy of the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners that applications which miss the filing deadline or have a significant incompleteness will not be considered for funding.
